APPA STATEMENT ON THE SITUATION OF CHILDREN IN GAZA, PALESTINE:

The Asia Pacific Pediatric Association (APPA) is deeply alarmed and saddened by the ongoing violence and atrocities being committed against the people, especially children, in Gaza. The loss of innocent lives, including children, is a grave concern that demands immediate international attention and

The siege on Gaza, which threatens to starve over a million children, is a humanitarian crisis that must be addressed urgently. This war on children is an indelible stain on the conscience of the world. We call upon the United Nations and the world's powerful leaders to utilize their influence and take immediate action to put an end to the vicious killing of children in Gaza. Specifically, we urge the following:

- 1. Immediate Ceasefire: We demand an immediate ceasefire that halts Israel's bombing of areas with children and ensures the protection of innocent lives.
- 2. Release of Palestinian Children: Thousands of Palestinian children are held in Israeli military prisons. We implore the relevant authorities to secure their release and ensure their wellbeing.
