1. Education Development.

In recent years, the Paediatrics & Child Health Division of The Royal Australasian College of Physicians (RACP) has modernised its education program and assessment tools and this continues to be rolled out throughout Australia and New Zealand. 2. Health policy and advocacy.

As you may be aware, in Australia a Federal election was held and in the lead up to this, the Division partnered with a number of peak bodies involved in child and youth health to develop a joint paper for Government outlining priority areas. Another important development is the development of National Standards for the Care of Children and Adolescents in Health Services. 3. 27th International Pediatric Association (IPA) Congress of Pediatrics.
